

ORDINANCE NO 41-76

To amend Ordinance No. 29-71 providing a curfew for minors.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 29-71 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. No minor, under the age of eighteen (18) years, shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets or other public places or upon private property, except upon private property where the minor resides and with the permission of the parent or guardian of such minor, during the period between 12:00 midnight and 4:30 A.M., unless accompanied by the minor's parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or unless such minor is on an emergency errand or legitimate business at the direction of the parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
