


ORDINANCE NO. 46 -76

To authorize the Mayor to employ Eugene R. Krumm, Jr. as a consultant in the Police Department for ~~three months~~, and to declare an emergency.


A PERIOD ENDING FEB 20, 1977

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to employ Eugene R. Krumm, Jr. as a consultant in the Police Department, commencing November 16, 1976, for a period of ~~three months~~ ^{ENDING FEB 20, 1977} at the same salary he is now receiving, and the sum of Forty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$4500.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to be used to pay for such consultation services.

Section 2. This Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the knowledge of the former Chief may be necessary at any time during the immediate future, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.


