ORDINANCE NO. 47-76

To authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus for collection of Income Tax, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council finds that it will be to the best interests of the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus for the administration of and collection of the Bexley Income Tax.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley with the City of Columbus for the administration and collection of the Bexley Income Tax.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the tax is effective January 1, 1977 and authority must be given Columbus to collect the same, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
