

ORDINANCE NO. 49 76

To grant a special permit to the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) is hereby granted permission to construct and maintain a bus shelter on city property in front of 2294 E. Main Street, said shelter to be 12 feet long, 5 feet deep and 7 feet high and to be located approximately 10 feet from the curb and centered approximately 120 feet east of the Drexel Avenue right of way.

Section 2. That this permission is granted on the condition that if the City of Bexley should ever decide that the interest of the City requires the removal of said shelter, it shall be removed immediately by COTA or the current owner of the shelter, at no cost to the City of Bexley.

Section 3. That this permission is granted on the condition that COTA shall execute a hold harmless agreement with the City of Bexley, said agreement to be approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; said emergency being that the winter season is now upon us and that construction of the shelter should be undertaken immediately to provide timely shelter for the general public and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
