

ORDINANCE NO. 51-76

To increase the salary of the Solicitor for the term commencing January 1, 1977, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the charter of the City of Bexley requires that any increases or decreases in the Solicitor's salary must be by ordinance effective prior to the commencement of the term to be affected; and

WHEREAS, in recent years the time required to effectively and adequately carry on the duties and responsibilities of the Solicitor has increased and there has been no increase in his salary since 1974; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to recognize the same and adjust the salary of the Solicitor for the term commencing January 1, 1977; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the annual salary of the Solicitor is hereby increased to \$7,800.00 for the year 1977 and the years thereafter, to be paid in equal monthly installments, said increase being permitted by the provisions of Section 31 of the charter giving Council the right to increase or decrease the salary providing the ordinance is effective prior to the beginning of the term to be affected.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare for the reasons stated in the preamble; Wherefore this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
