

ORDINANCE NO. 3 -77

To amend Ordinance No. 7-76 in regards to Holidays and rates of pay, effective January 1, 1977, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. This section amends Section 4 of Ordinance No. 7-76 by adding an additional Holiday for Columbus Day as celebrated by the Federal Government. This shall be considered a paid holiday.

Section 2. This section amends Schedule I of Ordinance No. 7-76 by inserting the following schedule of wages for the Police Department. These new wages are effective January 1, 1977.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective as of January 1, 1977.

Section 6. That all ordinances of parts of ordinances inconsistent here-
with are hereby repealed as of January 1, 1977, and this ordinance is an emergency
measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
safety, said emergency being that these wages have been promised to employees as of
January 1, 1977, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage
and approval by the Mayor.
