

ORDINANCE NO 9 -77

To appropriate Six Hundred Dollars for the payment of clerks at evening meetings and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That each person who acts as the clerk at meetings of Bexley Council, Bexley Planning Commission and Bexley Board of Zoning Appeals shall be paid the sum of Ten Dollars per meeting.

Section 2. That the sum of Six Hundred Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for such purpose.

Section 3. That the third paragraph of Schedule II of Ordinance No. 7-76 is hereby repealed. Said paragraph is as follows:

" The position of Secretary to the Mayor and Auditor shall include the duty of attending council meetings and such clerical work as is necessary. The position of Secretary to the Building Department shall include the duty of attending Board of Zoning Appeals and Planning Commission meetings and such clerical work as is necessary".

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that it is necessary to make immediate arrangements for clerks at said meetings, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
