

ORDINANCE NO. 10-77

To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of replacing the underground gas service lines at the Bexley Municipal Building, 2242 East Main Street.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the existing gas service line is broken and natural gas service has been turned off until the repairs are made, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
