

ORDINANCE NO. 11-77

To appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of thirty one thousand, seven hundred and forty four dollars (\$31,744.00) is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of operating a CETA Title VI Special Project. Said funds are to be reimbursed to the City of Bexley by the City of Columbus, the delegated administrative entity of the Columbus-Franklin County CETA Consortium.

Section 2. That the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing supplies and materials to be used in the development of a park in South Bexley. Said funds are to be reimbursed to the City of Bexley by the Bexley Jaycees.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
