

ORDINANCE NO. 12 -77

To amend and supplement Section 76 of Ordinance No. 19-69
by adding paragraphs regulating bicycles and motor-assisted vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 76 of Ordinance No. 19-69 is hereby
amended and supplemented by adding the following paragraphs:

(e) Whenever any person is riding a bicycle upon a sidewalk
or in a public park, such person shall yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian
and shall give an audible signal before overtaking and passing such pedestrian.

(f) No person shall ride any motorcycle, mini-bike, motor-
scooter, motor assisted bicycle or moped on any sidewalk or in any public
park in this city, nor in or upon any school ground in this city except as
permitted by regulation adopted by the school authority in charge of such
ground.

(g) No person shall operate any motor-assisted bicycle or
vehicle with more than one brake horsepower, or which is capable of a speed
in excess of 20 miles per hour, or which is driven by gear or chain and not
friction driven, upon any public highway, roadway or other public property
unless such person, upon application, has been licensed as an operator or
chauffeur by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles under Sections 4507. 01 to
4507. 39, inclusive, of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force
from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
