

ORDINANCE NO 16 -77

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with Heritage House for the services of the Geriatrics Service Organization, and to appropriate Four Thousand Dollars.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Heritage House for the services of their Geriatrics Service Organization to senior citizens of Bexley over 60 years old which consists of counseling by social workers; transportation to doctors, dentists and for shopping; light housekeeping; meals on wheels; information referral to other agencies; discussion groups; and other similar services. Each applicant will be interviewed by a social worker who will decide the nature and extent of the services to be furnished.

Section 2. That the sum of Four Thousand Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered general fund to pay the cost of such services for the remainder of 1977.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
