

ORDINANCE NO. 19 -77

By John A. Flanberg
Providing for the purchase of three automobiles for the use of
the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are,
authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of three
new 4-door Sedans for the use of the Police Department, the complete
specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office
of the Mayor, and to trade in thereon one 1971 ^{Ford} 4-door Galaxie Sedan.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and
best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of Seventeen
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$17,500.00) is hereby appropriated
from the unincumbered General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for
the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety,
said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said
automobiles for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate
force and effect.
