

ORDINANCE NO. 36 -77

To repeal existing Paragraph 17 of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 22-71 and enact a revised Paragraph 17 to replace it, to repeal Ordinance No. 16-62, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2, Paragraph 17 of Ordinance No. 22-71 is hereby repealed and a new Paragraph 17 enacted as follows:

17. Dogs

No dogs are permitted on any part of the Jeffrey Park property or on any part of the park being constructed along Alum Creek adjacent to Astor Avenue.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 16-62 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance <sup>shall take effect</sup> ~~is an emergency measure~~ ~~and be in force from and after the earliest period necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the use of our parks by our residents is being endangered by dogs, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon the passage and approval by the Mayor.~~
