To rescind a contract between the City and Bob Keim Ford, Inc., and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That a certain contract between the City and Bob Keim Ford, Inc., hereby is rescinded, said contract being formed at or about 9:00 A.M., August 2, 1977, upon acceptance by the Board of Control of the bid of Bob Keim Ford, Inc. for the sale of three automobiles to the City, at a price of \$4,294.20 each, said rescission being proper because of an obvious error in said bid, the next lowest bid having been \$5,828.06 each.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City needs police cruisers and cannot advertize for them until the existing contract is rescinded, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
