


ORDINANCE NO. 38-77

By: 

To re-imburse the Mayor's Court Bond Fund Account for funds stolen and not compensated for by City insurance, and to declare an emergency


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$471.00) payable in the amounts of Four Hundred Forty-three Dollars (\$443.00) to the Mayor's Court Bond Fund and Twenty-Eight (\$28.00) to the Police Petty Cash Fund.

Section 2. That the said amounts are to be used to re-imburse the said funds for moneys taken in a burglary of the Police Administrative Offices on August 4, 1977.


Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that these funds are needed for the proper distribution of bonds in the Mayor's Court and the administration of the Police Department, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
