

ORDINANCE NO. 41-77

To appropriate funds to pay the agreed settlement in the case of Kenneth L. Carter-vs-City of Bexley and the legal fees in connection therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1.

That the sum of One Thousand Fifty Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying Chester, Saxbe, Hoffman and Willcox \$750.00 for the services furnished by Robert D. Zitko in connection with the hearing held before the Board of Review, Ohio Bureau of Unemployment Services on December 3, 1975, on an appeal filed by Kenneth L. Carter and in connection with the case of Kenneth L. Carter-vs-City of Bexley, filed July 9, 1975, Case No. 75CV-07-2845 and for the purpose of reimbursing said firm for the sum of \$300.00 paid in full settlement of the latter case with the approval of the Mayor.

Section 2.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
