

ORDINANCE NO. 42-77

To amend Ordinance No. 3-77 to add a classification for Police Radio Dispatchers, ~~and to declare an emergency.~~

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3-77, amending Schedule II of Ordinance No. 7-76, be amended by adding the following:

Police Radio Dispatchers                      \$8,000 - 9,500

Section 2. That any such Police Radio Dispatcher is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase various articles of clothing and accessories to be worn as part of his uniform as prescribed by the Mayor, not exceeding the sum of \$200.00 per calendar year.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to be used to pay the cost of one (1) Police Radio Dispatcher for the balance of the calendar year 1977.

Section 4. ~~This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Department is in need of a Radio Dispatcher to free another man for patrol duty, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.~~

*That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.*
