


ORDINANCE NO. 50 -77


To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Two Hundred Thirty (\$230.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of replacing the water tap and underground water service lines at the Jeffrey Mansion cottage, 2080 Clifton Avenue.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the existing water service line is broken and water service has been turned off until the repairs are made, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
