
To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred (\$1,700.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of five (5) twin bar light assemblies; three (3) for the new Police Sedans and two (2) as replacements for existing bars.



This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said completely equipped automobiles for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
