

ORDINANCE NO. 53 -77

To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Ten (\$1,210.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Street Construction Maintenance Fund for the purpose of rebuilding, repairing, replacing controllers and/or amplifiers in addition to routine maintenance of traffic lights at specified locations. To modify cam breakouts plus parts at the eight (8) Main Street intersections per the Traffic Engineer's instructions. Service calls to repair and refurbish the marbelite traffic signal controllers at five (5) Broad Street intersections and eight (8) Main Street intersections. Rebuild equipment as specified.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic lights are in need of preventive maintenance to enable them to function in a trouble free manner thus providing safe traffic flow within the City of Bexley. Said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
