

ORDINANCE NO. 54-77

To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing a new lawn mower to replace the existing one at Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the existing lawn mower is worn out and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
