

RESOLUTION NO. 9 -78

Declaring the intention of the council that taxes against real property for the year 1979, not otherwise affected by the provisions of Section 319.301, Revised Code, or the Commissioner of Tax Equalization, be limited to the sums actually levied against such property for the year 1978; that any such windfall increase because of the triennial reappraisal be rejected; and that the Franklin County Auditor and the Franklin County Budget Commission be so advised.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor immediately notify the Franklin County Auditor and the Franklin County Budget Commission that it is the position of this council that the City of Bexley desires the ten-mill limitation against real property for the year 1979 to the same number of dollars, exclusive of sums levied against improvements or additions to the tax list during the past year, as was charged against all real property in the City of Bexley by such taxes in the year 1978.

Section 2. That nothing in this resolution is intended to apply to the three-mill street lighting levy passed by the voters of the City of Bexley in June of 1978, or to other voted millage already subject to the property tax reduction provisions of Section 319.301, Revised Code.
