

ORDINANCE NO. 15 -78

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with The Justinian Publishing Company for the codification of the laws of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with The Justinian Publishing Company for the codification of the laws of the City of Bexley and a supplemental agreement with the same company to prepare, print and publish "Tables of Special Ordinances" in conjunction with said codification, without advertisement because of the specialized nature of the contract and the peculiar skill and ability required to complete it.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare for the reason that lack of codification is interfering with necessary actions and activities and permits confusion, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
