

ORDINANCE NO. 17 -78

To approve and ratify the letter agreement between the City and the Jennings-Lawrence Company for engineering services and to appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the letter agreement between the City of Bexley and the Jennings-Lawrence Company dated January 31, 1978, to provide engineering services for the proposed street light project is hereby approved, without advertisement because of the extensive investigation made by the City into various engineering firms, because they are city engineers, and because of their knowledge and skill with regard to Bexley installations. Said services are essential to the City in order to place a bond issue for street lights on the June 6, 1978 ballot. The total costs of said services shall not exceed the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

Section 2. That the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of such services.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest allowed by law.
