

ORDINANCE No. 27-78

Authorizing the negotiation of a contract to install plastic traffic lines on East Main Street and repair the lines on East Broad Street and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the installation of new plastic traffic lines on East Main Street and to repair the plastic lines on East Broad Street, the total cost of the same not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Street Maintenance and Repair Fund to pay the cost of the same.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that in order to properly direct and control traffic such installation is needed as soon as possible and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
