

ORDINANCE NO. 26-78

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the sum of \$1000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of replacing five dead trees in the Fair Avenue park strip.

Section 2. That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing an above ground oil tank for the storage of mosquito control oil.

Section 3. That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing an air conditioner and carpeting for the office of the Health Commissioner.

Section 4. That the sum of \$2400.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund for the purpose of purchasing a new spray paint machine for pavement marking.

Section 5. That the sum of \$5000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of finishing Bexley Park along Alum Creek, South of Main Street.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
