

ORDINANCE NO. 27 -78

To appropriate funds to assist the Bexley Historical Society with its promotion of ~~its First Bexley May Chautauque~~ background booklet.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as an advance to the Bexley Historical Society to help it pay the cost of printing of a booklet promoting ~~the First Bexley May Chautauque~~, which booklet will contain information concerning the early history of the City of Bexley when it was a village as well as later years, and other interesting information.

Section 2. This advance is authorized on the express condition ^{NOT LESS THAN} that all said booklets shall be sold for \$2.50 each or distributed to persons paying \$4.00 for a tour arranged by said Society, and the proceeds from each booklet sold shall be paid to the City of Bexley ~~and the sum of \$2.50 for each booklet so distributed shall be paid to the City of Bexley~~, and until this advance is reimbursed to said City it shall retain ownership and possession of all plates used in printing said booklets, after which said City shall deliver them to the Bexley Historical Society.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
