

ORDINANCE NO. 29 -78

Authorizing the negotiation of a contract for resurfacing with asphaltic concrete all or parts of the streets listed below, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract for resurfacing, with asphaltic concrete, including such other specifications as have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor, the streets hereafter listed, with the provision that if the total cost of the same exceeds Ninety Thousand Two Hundred Forty-four Dollars (\$90,240.00), the City shall have the option to reduce the amount of such resurfacing, and a list of said streets is as follows:

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of Ninety Thousand Two Hundred Forty-four Dollars (\$90,244.00) is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance Fund to pay the cost of the same.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said resurfacing needs to be completed as soon as possible because of the dangerous condition resulting from last winter's weather and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
