

ORDINANCE NO. 30 -78

Authorizing the negotiation of a contract to surface treat, using an asphaltic emulsion commonly known as slurry sealing, all or parts of the streets listed below, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract to surface treat, using an asphaltic emulsion commonly known as slurry sealing, the following streets:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
Euclaire Ave.	Main St.	Livingston Ave.
Pleasant Ridge	Mound St.	Francis Ave.
Remington Road	Main St.	Livingston Ave.

with the provision that if the total cost of the same exceeds Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$13,900.00), the City shall have the option to reduce the amount of such slurry sealing, and the specifications for such treatment are on file in the Mayor's office.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$13,900.00) is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund to pay the cost of the same.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said sealing needs to be completed as soon as possible because of the dangerous condition resulting from last winter's weather, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
