

ORDINANCE NO. 36-78

To authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a used L 8541-209 Burroughs ~~mini~~ Mini-computer, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Auditor has immediate need for better and more sophisticated bookkeeping equipment to keep adequate records in order to preserve the interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, he has decided, after a thorough investigation, that a Burroughs L8541-209 Mini-computer is the best qualified machine for his needs; and

WHEREAS, considerable money can be saved The City if a used machine can be purchased and the Burroughs representative has offered to try to locate one and has agreed to accept our present bookkeeping machine in trade; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That in order to preserve the interests of the City, the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of an acceptable used Burroughs L 8541-209 Mini-computer, with one cassette station, FDR/STKR, 6KE user memory, 20CPS Printer, and PF29 dual pin-feed, and to trade in thereon the City's Burroughs bookkeeping machine, the total net cost of the same including delivery and handling and a one year maintenance contract, not to exceed the sum of \$10,400.00.

Section 2. That the sum of \$10,400.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of the same.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Auditor is unable to properly keep his books and records and preserve the interests of the City with his present equipment, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
