ORDINANCE NO. 4ν 78

To repeal Ordinance No. 36-78 which authorized the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a used L8541-209 Burroughs Minicomputer, and to authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Burroughs L9911-209 Minicomputer, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Auditor has immediate need for better and more sophisticated bookkeeping equipment to keep adequate records in order to preserve the interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, he has been trying to find a used Burroughs L8541-209 Mini-computer in accordance with the instructions in Ordinance No. 36-78 but has been unable to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City has been offered a Burroughs L9911-209 Mini-computer for immediate delivery at a 20% discount but acceptance of the offer and delivery of the equipment needs to be done at once and if action is delayed by advertising, the City's interests will not be adequately preserved; and

WHEREAS, the Burroughs L9911-209 system contains additional features which will be valuable to the City; and

WHEREAS, considerable money can be saved the City if it acts promptly; now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That in order to preserve the interests of the City, the Myor and the Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Burroughs L9911-209 Mini-computer system and to trade in thereon the City's Burroughs bookkeeping machine, the total net cost of the same, including programming in the amount of \$3400.00, not to exceed the sum of \$18,000.00.

Section 2. That the sum of \$18,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of the same.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 36-78 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Auditor is unable to properly keep his books and records and preserve the interests of the City with his present equipment, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
