

ORDINANCE NO. 43-78

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with The Jennings-Lawrence Co. for engineering services in connection with renovating our Street Lighting System and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council finds that it will be to the best interests of the City of Bexley to enter into a contract with The Jennings-Lawrence Co. for the purpose of providing the City with the necessary plans, specifications and estimates for requesting proposals to renovate the City Street Lighting System and to provide professional services during the construction program.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley with The Jennings-Lawrence Co. for the purposes stated in Section 1., the provisions of the same to be in accordance with the proposed agreement attached hereto for reference.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that to preserve the safety of the residents, replacement of the lighting system must be completed as soon as possible, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
