Providing for the purchase of one Cushman Police Vehicle with accessories and equipment for the use of the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract ~~with~~ advertising and bidding, for the purchase of one Cushman model 434 three wheel Police Vehicle with accessories and equipment for the use of the Police Department Parking Control Division, to replace the three wheel vehicle presently being used.

Section 2. That the sum of Four Thousand Six Hundred and Six Dollars (\$4,606.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for this purpose.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Parking Control vehicle presently in use is unsafe and in need of constant repair, and the daily use of such vehicle is needed to enforce the Traffic Code, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
