

ORDINANCE NO. 55 -78

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a Workers' Compensation Insurance Service Contract with The Frank Gates Service Co., to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Bexley, an agreement employing The Frank Gates Service Co., as a consultant to assist the City on all past and future workers' compensation insurance claims and hearings and anything incidental thereto for a period of fourteen months beginning November 1, 1978, and ending December 31, 1979 at a cost of \$100.00 per month, the form of such agreement to be in accordance with the proposed agreement attached hereto.

Section 2. That the sum of \$200.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of the same for the balance of 1978.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that their services are needed to represent the City at hearings already scheduled, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
