

ORDINANCE NO 59-78

To amend Ordinance No. 19-69, Section 78, paragraph (f), which provides for the impounding of vehicles found in violation of other sections of Ordinance No. 19-69, and providing for the impoundment and storage fees to be charged; and to repeal Ordinance No. 21-78, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That paragraph (f) of Section 78 of Ordinance 19-69 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(f) No vehicle impounded under the provisions of this section shall be removed from such pound except upon the payment by the owner, chauffeur, driver, or other persons in charge of such vehicle, of service and impounding charges and a storage charge not to exceed three dollars per day for each twenty-four hours, or fraction thereof; and further that the accumulated maximum storage charge to be collected on any automobile or vehicle shall not exceed two hundred dollars.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 21-78 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present impounding service will terminate on November 30, 1978 and the new impounding service beginning December 1, 1978 shall be based upon the above amendment by contract, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
