WHEREAS, a request has been made to this Council that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Sec. 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio is greater than that considered reasonable and safe on College Avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue, and

WHEREAS, this Council has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon the section of road described above, and

WHERZAS, it is the belief of this Council that such investigation confirms the allegation that the statutory speed limit of 35 mph is unrealistic,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio that:

Section 1. By virtue of the provisions of Sec. 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio the Director of Transportation is hereby requested to review the engineering and traffic investigation and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit on College Avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue in Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. That this Council believes a maximum of 25 mph would be a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit on said road and would be in conformance with all other residential speed limits within the City of Bexley, Ohio.

Section 3. That when this Council is advised that the Director of Transportation has determined and declared a reasonable and safe speed limit on the section of road described in Section 1 hereof, standard signs, properly posted and giving notice thereof will be erected.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall go into full force and effect upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
