


ORDINANCE NO. 3 -79

BY



A supplemental appropriations ordinance for current expenses and other expenditures of the city during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1979.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1: That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of a travel allowance for the Mayor's office.

Section 2: That the sum of \$1500.00 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the State Highway Fund for the purpose of purchasing salt for use on the streets and highways during freezing and icy weather.

Section 3: That the sum of \$2800.00 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund and set aside and appropriated from that fund for the purpose of painting and marking (by use of glass beads) the street pavements.


Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


