

WHEREAS, suitable and positive leisure experiences are vital to good physical and mental health and enhance the quality of life for all people, and,


WHEREAS, citizens can enjoy self-renewal in the out-of-doors through green spaces and facilities in parks, and,

WHEREAS, all citizens can fulfill their potential in the use of their leisure time through varied individual and group opportunities provided by recreation,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:






