

ORDINANCE NO. 7-79

BY



An Ordinance to make appropriations for additional capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1979.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the following sum be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for use for the Building Department:

(a) \$1200.00 for the purchase of a new typewriter.

Section 2: That the following sums be and they hereby are set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for use for the Recreation Department:

(a) \$600.00 for capital improvements at Jeffrey Mansion for the purchase of maintenance equipment;


(b) \$2000.00 for capital improvements at Jeffrey Mansion for purchase of a heater unit for the boiler.

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of the necessary equipment, labor and materials specifically identified in the previous two (2) sections, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sums so specified and appropriated in each section, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 4: Said contracts shall, when necessary, be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.


Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


