

ORDINANCE NO. 13 -79

An ordinance to eliminate the salaried position of Assistant Superintendent of Service and replace it with the position of Street Maintenance Foreman at an hourly wage rate and to amend existing legislation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That there is hereby created in the Service Department of this City the position of Street Maintenance Foreman to perform generally the former duties and responsibilities of the Assistant Superintendent of Service which shall include but not be limited to directing the various work crews of the Service Department as assigned to him and performing semi-skilled laboring tasks in connection with street and sewer construction, maintenance and repair;

Section 2: That a job description for this position be prepared by the Service Department for submission and adoption by the Bexley Civil Service Commission;

Section 3: That the hourly rate for the position be as follows:

Starting Rate	(Step 1)	\$4.65
After 120 Days	(Step 2)	4.80
After 1 Year	(Step 3)	5.20

Section 4: That the salaried position of Assistant Superintendent of Service is hereby eliminated and Schedule II of Ordinance 2-79 is hereby amended by removing such position from the list of salaried positions in the City; further, that Schedule III of Ordinance 2-79 is hereby amended by adding the newly created position of Street Maintenance Foreman to the list of hourly workers, subject to all the conditions, qualifications, and obligations of such schedule.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
