

ORDINANCE NO. 17 -79

To vacate unnamed and unimproved alley and right-of-way lying between and parallel to Roosevelt Avenue and Stanwood Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Subdivision known as Ardmore No. 2 Subdivision, was approved and accepted by ordinance passed by Bexley Village Council on May 9, 1911 and said subdivision was then duly recorded in Plat Book 11, pages 9 and 10.

Section 2: That all streets, alleys and rights-of-way indicated on said Subdivision were duly dedicated to the public use and duly accepted by the Village of Bexley, now the City of Bexley.

Section 3: That the alley lying between North Roosevelt Avenue and North Stanwood Road, running south from Maryland Avenue for approximately 583 feet, which is unnamed, is not now used and has never been used by the City, and will not be needed for any foreseeable future need and that the Planning Commission of the City unanimously recommended that the alley be vacated and that such action will not be detrimental to the public interest.

Section 4: That the unnamed unused alley described as follows:

A 16 foot strip, being a so-called alley, lying to the east of Lots 479-490 and to the west of Lots 467-478, Ardmore No. 2 Subdivision, and running from Maryland Avenue southerly for 583 feet, more or less, terminating at a line from the southwest corner of Lot 467 to the south-east corner of Lot 490;

shall be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned; provided, however, that the City of Bexley and all persons or companies engaged in the operation of public utilities shall retain, and have, the right to maintain in place, and to construct and erect, all sewers, conduits, pipes, poles, and wires and any other facilities used or useful in the rendition of public utility service and the right of ingress and egress thereover.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
