

ORDINANCE NO. 19-79

To provide for two (2) additional radio dispatchers for the Police Department; to provide for vacation compensation for all police radio dispatchers; to set salary guidelines and appropriate funds, and to amend existing Ordinance 2-79.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Schedule II of Ordinance 2-79 be amended as follows:

Police Radio Dispatchers (3) \$7,500 - \$8,560

Section 2: That Police Radio Dispatchers are authorized and empowered to purchase various articles of clothing and accessories as part of a uniform allowance, as prescribed by the Mayor, not exceeding \$200 per calendar year, and that the invoices for all such purchases be made to the City of Bexley and paid for by the Auditor.

Section 3: That Police Radio Dispatchers, consistent with the policy for all members of the Police Department, be paid compensation for each of the holidays listed in Section 4 of Ordinance 2-79, which shall be paid as part of the regular payroll in which the holiday occurs.

Section 4: That the sum of \$10,000 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the salaries of the two (2) additional Police Radio Dispatchers for the balance of the calendar year 1979.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
