

ORDINANCE NO. 24-79

An ordinance to appropriate funds for towing services performed by Noble's, Inc. during the year 1979 pursuant to the contract for such services, entered into between the City of Bexley and Noble's, Inc. on December 1, 1978.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That since the City of Bexley entered into a contract with Noble's, Inc. on December 1, 1978 to assist the Police Department by providing towing and storage services for motor vehicles parked and operated in violation of traffic and safety ordinances within the City of Bexley;

Section 2: That the contractor was to be paid for its services by the City from funds appropriated from the General Fund and that all towing, impounding, and storage fees assessed were to be collected by the City and deposited in the General Fund and that the contract was for a period of 37 months ending December 31, 1981;

Section 3: That pursuant to the obligations of the towing services contract, the sum of \$16,000.00 is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be used for paying for the towing, impounding, and storage fees incurred under the contract during the calendar year 1979;

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
