

ORDINANCE NO. 27-79

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company to supply energy for the street lighting system of the City of Bexley for a period of five (5) years and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bexley is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company for a period of five (5) years for electric energy for the street lighting system of the City of Bexley;

Section 2: That said contract, upon signing, shall be effective as of the date of this Ordinance and continue for a period of five (5) years thereafter so long as both parties comply with the terms of the contract;

Section 3: That the City shall pay for such energy consumed by the street lighting system in accordance with the schedule set forth in the contract, as follows:

<u>Type and Size in Lumens</u>	<u>Rate/Lamp/Month</u>
8,000 Lumen, Mercury Vapor	\$2.00
25,000 Lumen, Mercury Vapor	\$3.60

and in addition, pay a fuel cost adjustment as provided for in the contract and determined under the provisions of Chapter 4901:1-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; said emergency being that the new contract rates apply to the newly installed street lighting system which cannot be operated until the contract is signed, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
