


ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 79

BY:



To appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the sum of \$6,300.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing a new four wheel drive truck for use by the City Maintenance Department.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of the necessary vehicle identified in Section 1., the total cost of which shall not exceed the sums so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.


Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
