An ordinance to authorize the purchase of three (3) additional police cruisers during fiscal year 1979, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$21,000 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the General Fund for use for the Police Department for the purchase of three (3) new police cruisers.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of said police cruisers, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3: That said contract or contracts shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisements according to law and that said advertisements shall be combined with those already authorized for police cruisers in Ordinance 4-79 and that all such police cruisers be bid as a package.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, because of the limited availability of police cruisers, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
