To grant a special permit to the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) is hereby granted permission to construct and maintain bus shelters at the following locations: 1. north side of East Broad Street, approximately 100 feet west of the intersection of North Cassingham Road; 2. south side of East Main Street, approximately 50 feet west of the intersection of Chelsea Avenue. Said shelters shall be 12 feet 10 inches long, 5 feet deep and 7 feet high.

Section 2. That this permission is granted on the condition that if the City of Bexley should ever decide that the interest of the City requires the removal of said shelters, it shall be removed immediately by COTA or the current owner of the shelter, at no cost to the City of Bexley.

Section 3. That this permission is granted on the condition that COTA shall execute a hold harmless agreement with the City of Bexley, said agreement to be approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
