

ORDINANCE NO. 47-79

An ordinance to appropriate funds for use as a petty cash account by the Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City has heretofore maintained a petty cash account in the Police Department, Violations Bureau, to assist those persons desiring to pay traffic tickets, post bail bond, or do business with the City after the other city offices had closed;

Section 2: That the money previously held in such account has now been lost or misplaced and cannot be located and it is now necessary to reimburse that account for the money lost in order to continue to provide 24-hour service availability to the community;

Section 3: That the sum of \$100.00 be and it is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Mayor's Court Trust Account for use as a petty cash account by Police Department personnel for the purposes, among others, set forth and identified in Section 1.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
