

ORDINANCE NO. 48-79

To authorize the Mayor to execute a contract with Gregory S. Lashutka, City Attorney for Columbus, for the Prosecution of certain cases before the Franklin County Municipal Court, Criminal Division, and to represent the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in certain cases in Franklin County Municipal Court, Civil Division, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Gregory S. Lashutka, City Attorney for Columbus, for the prosecution of certain cases before the Franklin County Municipal Court, Criminal Division, and to represent the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in certain cases in Franklin County Municipal Court, Civil Division, during the calendar year 1979, a complete copy of which contract is attached hereto for reference.

Section 2: That the sum of \$1,500.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from unencumbered General Fund to be used for the legal services provided pursuant to said contract.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being that representation in the Franklin County Municipal Court is necessary for the adequate operation of our Police Department, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
