

ORDINANCE NO. 49 -79

To authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley with the Sheriff and the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to house, board, and maintain those prisoners imprisoned under the ordinances of the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Bexley does not have a work-house or other jail for imprisonment of those who violate ordinances of the City and under the provisions of Section 1905.35, Revised Code of Ohio, may contract with the Board of County Commissioners for use of the county jail for such purposes at the expense of the City.

Section 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Sheriff and the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, to receive, safely keep, board and maintain in the Franklin County Corrections Center (County Jail) those prisoners who are imprisoned under the ordinances of the City of Bexley, a complete copy of which contract is attached hereto for reference;

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety for the reason the adequate jail facilities are necessary for the complete exercise of the police powers of the City and effective operation of the Police Department, and this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
